Uniform Policy

When students attend Trinity Academy Grammar they are expected to achieve standards of excellence in all areas of academy life including appearance, therefore, it is important that a smart uniform is worn. It is hoped that it will instil pride, support positive behaviour and discipline and encourage identity with and support for the academy ethos. A key reason for the academy uniform is to ensure students of all races and social and economic backgrounds feel welcome and protect students from social pressures to dress in a particular way.

Students at the academy are expected to wear correct uniform at all times. When uniform is worn inappropriately or incorrect pieces of uniform are worn, appropriate sanctions will be put in place.

Academy uniform

Blue blazer with embroidered logo

White shirt/blouse

Academy tie - blue with light blue stripe

Plain black formal school trousers or a knee-length pleated black skirt

Plain black tights or black socks

Plain black flat shoes (no pumps, trainers or boots of any description)

Religious headwear must be plain black

A single, minimal black hair accessory

If required to wear a face mask, this must be plain black

Physical Education uniform

Polo shirt with embroidered logo Quarter zip training top with embroidered logo Blue shorts with embroidered logo and/or tracksuit bottoms with embroidered logo Blue TAG football socks and/or plain white sports socks

Expectations are that students must bring PE kit to all lessons. This is to ensure that all students are engaged in lessons regardless of the amount of physical contribution they can make; if this is limited they will be involved in the lesson in other aspects such as coaching, officiating or choreography. Wearing kit will prevent their academy uniform from getting dirty and allow every student to play a full part in PE lessons. Sanctions are in place for students when they fail to bring their kit for PE lessons.

Equipment: Students will be expected to be 'equipped to learn'. It is essential they bring a range of stationery equipment every day. This equipment should include:

A sensible school bag (big enough to fit an A4 folder)

Blue or black pen (preferably with a spare)

Pencil

Rubber

Ruler

Planner

Scientific calculator

In addition, the Academy will provide key stage 3 students with a reading book and knowledge organiser, which they will be expected to have with them each day.

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Jewellery: The only items of jewellery allowed are a plain wrist watch and one plain ear stud worn in the lobes of the ear. All other items of jewellery including visible piercings are not allowed. Students will not be permitted to cover piercings with plasters. Piercings must be removed.

Any student wearing nail varnish will be asked to remove it with products supplied by the academy. False nails are not permitted.

Students are allowed to wear subtle make-up. Sanctions are in place for students who wear unsuitable make-up to the academy. Hair must be neat and tidy with no 'extreme' styles, two-tone colours or unnatural colours. Fashion styles, including very short hair with patterns etc. cut into the hair are not permitted. Hair fashion items are not allowed. Long hair must be tied back in practical lessons for health and safety reasons.

Outdoor Coats: should be a single subdued colour and plain material.

Items made from denim, leather, sweatshirts, hooded tops, sportswear, cardigans or jumpers are not allowed. Clothing must not be decorated with names, pictures, logos, slogans or badges. **None of the above should replace the academy blazer.**
