Dear Parent/Carer,

Since home learning began we have been offering feedback to students through the use of MyMaths and Seneca Learning, using both platforms to set assignments linked to the home learning on Sharepoint. Information on how your child has been performing in these assignments has also been sent to all users of the 'My Child at School (MCAS)' app to ensure you are up to date with how your child is engaging with home learning (please sign up for this app if you haven't already; emails have been set to all parents with instructions on how to do this). In addition, we have been making phone calls to parents and throughout this crisis we have been available to provide individual feedback over email.

We intend to carry on with all of the above but we are now going to start offering an further opportunity for your child to receive feedback from their teachers. Each week one subject for each year group will have a task highlighted in the home learning pack as a 'Feedback Opportunity'. In order to receive personalised feedback your child needs to complete the highlighted task and email it to their usual classroom teacher by 3pm on Thursday. Your child will then receive a response from their classroom teacher with a target for how their work can be improved.

The subject which students will receive feedback from will change each week. For the week commencing 8 June 2020 the subjects each year group can receive feedback on are:

- Year 7 – Technology
- Year 8 – Maths
- Year 9 – Science
- Year 10 – English

A list of email addresses for your child to submit their work to will also be included in the home learning pack on Sharepoint.
